Figures of eight

Reels of three on sides and across

Promenade for 2 and 3 couples

Allemande for 2 and 3 couples

Ladies’ chain

Men’s chain

Poussette in strathspey/jig/reel

Rights and lefts

Double figure of eights

Double triangles

Set and rotate for 2 and 3 couples

Knot for 2 and 3 couples

Set to and turn corners

Set to and turn partner

Reel of three after above formations

Reel of 4 on the diagonal

Reel of 4 across starting from side

Reel of 3 in tandem changing lead
